

### English—Little Red Riding Hood

We will be reading Little Red Riding Hood and retelling the story in the correct order. Our focus this half term will be applying our phonics, using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.



### Maths—Place Value

In maths we are learning about place value with numbers to 20. We are learning to count forwards and backwards and how to use number lines. Later on in the half term we will be moving onto addition and subtraction and the focus will be on number bonds to 10. For example:



$$0+10=10 \quad 1+9=10 \quad 2+8=10 \quad 3+7=10$$

### Science—Seasonal Changes

Each week we are going to focus on a different season and how the weather changes. At the end of the half term we are going to make rain catchers and measure how much it rains.



### RE—What do Christians believe God is like?

In RE we are learning about parables. Parables are stories from the bible that teach us. Our parable for this half term is The Lost Son and it teaches us forgiveness.

### Art—Explore and Draw

We will be going outside to look at all the wonderful things nature has to offer. We will then choose parts of nature to make repetitive patterns and bring them into our classroom to practice our sketching skills!



### Music—Hands Feet Heart

Our song that we will be learning is Hand Feet Heart. We will be exploring the lyrics and learning them. We will be learning new vocabulary such as tempo and beat.



### Geography—Where do I live?



Our topic this half term is, 'Where do I live?' Each week we will look at different aspects of what it means to live somewhere and the differences between a village, town and a city.

### Computing—Beebots

Beebots have arrows on them and we will be programming them to move in a sequence. Whilst we learn to move them round we will also be practising logging on and off the laptops.
