JUBBLIES

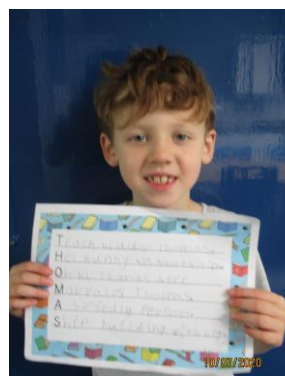
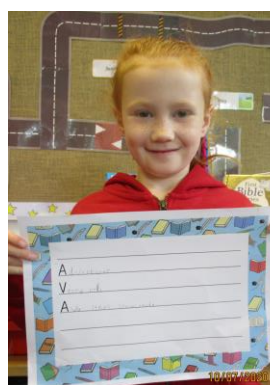
